

Annual Canvass 2026

Check your household's electoral register details

Wealden District Council is carrying out its annual canvass to ensure that the electoral register is accurate and up to date.

Over the coming weeks and months, residents may be contacted by:

- Email
- Post
- Telephone
- A personal visit

Around 80,000 emails are being sent using the government's GOV.UK Notify service. These emails will come from:

wealden.district.council.elections.department@notifications.service.gov.uk

The email will not contain your address or the names of anyone registered at your property. It will provide a unique security code and ask you to visit the secure household response website to check and confirm the details held for your address.

Only one person per household needs to respond

Residents receiving an email are asked to respond by **9 September 2026** to avoid a paper form being sent to their property.

You should confirm or update the details of everyone aged 16 or over who lives at the address, including their nationality.

Please note that adding someone to the annual canvass response does not register them to vote. Anyone who needs to register must also apply separately at:
